#### BIO

Porter Brotherhood is an indie—soul outfit from Southend-on-Sea led by songwriter/ producer Gary Porter. Built for rooms of any size, the band moves from sweat-close club sets to precision-timed stadium support with ease—stacked harmonies, horn firepower, and songs that land on first listen. The upcoming single Rise Up (Nov 2025) tees up the new album 139 Steps (Jan 2026): hook-bright choruses, gritty, overdriven guitars with a percussive bite, and elaborate Hammond organ and synth textures riding over a rhythm section that sits deep in the pocket. While Porter's past records earned critical nods and loyal listeners, this chapter is about momentum. The live show scales from a tight 5-piece to a full 10-piece with three horns and two backing singers, delivering a groove-first set that keeps crowds moving and choruses ringing. Recording mirrors the stage approach—real instruments, wide dynamics, vocals up front, and stories that get to the point. Indie grit meets soul feel; classic textures meet modern punch.
